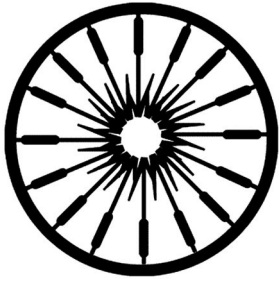
Shop Destination Downtown & WIN!
