If you plan to put signs, merchandise, outdoor seating, etc. outside your business this Spring/Summer. You must fill out a PROW Application found at our office or on our website.

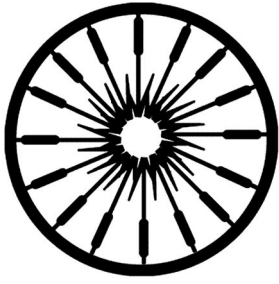
