Main Street's Fifth Annual Casino Night

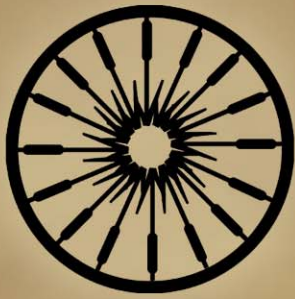

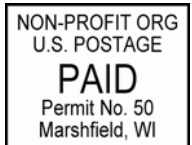
